	An old building which may be somewhat commonplace but whose historic origin is still recognizable. Architectural significance may be diminished by loss of detail or use of modern materials, but it nevertheless contributes to the general area development.		
	An old building that is lacking in architectural distinction due to a high degree of alteration or addition. It is not compatible with the historic environment and does not contribute to the general area development.		
	A non-contributing modern building constructed after 1954.
